HOLE 1-18 DESCRIPTION

- 01** Slight dogleg right with trees guarding the left side of the hole. It is very rewarding to be aggressive off the tee for a short approach shot onto the green.
- 02** A long par 4, where it will reward the long drivers, but be careful of the well-placed bunkers to the right which will guard against wayward drives.
- 03** A relatively forgiving par 3, with water guarding the left side and back of the green. Make sure to choose your club wisely, as the green slopes back to front, hitting the ball with too much club will leave you with a challenging up and down to save par.
- 04** A challenging long par 4, with water guarding the right side of the fairway and green. A wayward shot leading to the right will cost you a stroke, so make sure to choose the right club off the tee.
- 05** Large fairway bunker protects the left side of one of the widest fairways on the golf course. Aim for the 150 marker and swing away!!
- 06** Be wary of the left side of the fairway as hole #7 is out of bounds from 6 tee. Water straight away through the fairway can make this a tough driving hole.
- 07** A challenging dogleg right par 4, smart play would be to hit a long iron or wood at the 150 marker for a mid or short iron into the green. Fairway bunkers protect the left side of the fairway.
- 08** Short par 3, with well-placed bunkers around the green, make sure your short iron game is strong or this hole can make you pay.
- 09** One of the shorter par 4s Greentee Country Club has to offer, it is well guarded with trees lining both sides of the fairway, with bunkers left and right.
- 10** A long par 4 into the signature great wall. There is water on the right side of the fairway, but there should be ample room to hit the driver off the tee.
- 11** A challenging par 3, with water guarding the right side of the green, which slopes towards the water.
- 12** There is penalty area over the back and to the left of the green. The smart play is to hit a long iron or wood off the tee for optimal placement.
- 13** A long par 5, with woods lining the right side of the fairway for the entirety of the hole. Small pond on the left side of the fairway protects the landing area off the tee. Well placed bunkers surround a tight green, making this one of the toughest holes on the course.
- 14** A mid-range par 3 with the green sloping from right to left and trees guarding the right side for the entire hole.
- 15** A par 5, with trees lining the right side, and water surrounding the back of the green, making your second shot for long hitters quite a challenge.
- 16** A straight but long par 4, favoring the long hitters off the tee. A well-placed tee shot can leave an easy approach shot.
- 17** A par 5 with a small dogleg right, small ponds guard the landing area on the left and right side of the fairway. Trees line both sides of the fairway, with bunkers protecting the front left and right sides of the green and water over the back.
- 18** GreenTee Country Club's signature hole that overlooks the Fraser Valley. A short par 4 that has dangers to the right and left of the green. The smart play for this hole is to hit a mid iron off the tee for an easy second shot with a birdie opportunity.
